Malbec-Petit Verdot 2020

Vineyards

From our San Rafael Estate in the Maule Valley. The vineyards, which are over 20 years old, are planted on soils of volcanic origin on slopes with differing levels of solar exposure. The Mediterranean climate here has clearly defined seasons with dry summers and wet winters. These edaphoclimatic conditions result in the production of concentrated grapes with optimal ripeness.

Vinification

The grapes are harvested between April and May and are fermented in stainless steel tanks at temperatures between 77°F and 82.4°F. The level of extraction is decided on a daily basis through tasting by our winemakers. Once the malolactic fermentation is complete, the wine is aged, some in a mixture of new and used French and American oak barrels for a period that varies according to the batch and level of oak contribution required. Meanwhile, a percentage of the wine is retained in stainless steel tanks to achieve a balance between the fruit and the hints of oak.

Tasting Notes

Color: Intense violet red.

Aroma: Red and black fruit, leather and spices.

Flavour: Strawberries and floral notes, blackberries and spices. Excellent balance between tannins and acidity.
